

TOWN OF LOGANSPOUR  
MINUTES  
August 13, 2013

The regular meeting of the Logansport Town Council was held Tuesday, August 13, 2013 at 6:00 p.m. in the Council Chamber with Mayor Katherine Freeman presiding. Council members present: Norman Arbuckle, Judge Cordray, Martha Guillotte, and Edith Williams. Absent: Dale Morvan. Eight guests were in attendance.

The meeting opened in prayer led by Robert Bagley and the Pledge of Allegiance.

The July minutes were approved as written with a motion from Mr. Cordray and second from Mr. Arbuckle. All ayes, one absent.

General fund bills were approved with a motion from Mr. Arbuckle and second from Mrs. Guillotte. All ayes, one absent.

Utility fund bills were approved with a motion from Mrs. Williams and second from Mr. Cordray. All ayes, one absent.

An ordinance to abandon Jack Drive, a dedicated but unopened street within the corporate limits, was introduced with a motion from Mr. Cordray and second from Mr. Arbuckle with a public hearing called for 9/10/13 at 6:00 p.m. for comments. All ayes, one absent.

The following resolutions pertaining to the 2014-2015 LCDBG Sewer Application were unanimously approved, one absent:

1. Procurement Policy Resolution—Motion from Mrs. Williams, second from Mrs. Guillotte.
2. Request for Administrative Consultants' Proposals—Motion from Mr. Cordray, second from Mr. Arbuckle.
3. Request for Engineer's Qualifications' Statements—Motion from Mr. Williams, second from Mrs. Guillotte.

Jean Border addressed the Council with concerns regarding code violations, traffic violations, council meeting agenda & minutes, and term limits. No council action was taken on any of her concerns.

Deborah Roberts, Code Enforcement officer, reported 11 letters have been mailed to various property owners requesting the property be cleaned and/or mowed. She has had approximately 50% to respond positively.

Mayor Freeman reported that both Texas & Louisiana had approved the James Company out of Ruston, LA for the construction of the 84 Bridge Project.

With no further business to discuss, the meeting adjourned with a motion from Mr. Cordray and second from Mr. Arbuckle. All ayes, one absent.
