

TOWN OF LOGANSPOUR
MINUTES
February 12, 2013

The regular meeting of the Logansport Town Council was held Tuesday, February 12, 2013, at 6:00 p.m. in the Council Chamber with Mayor Katherine Freeman presiding. Council members present: Norman Arbuckle, Judge Cordray, Martha Guillotte, Dale Morvan, and Edith Williams. Absent: None. Fifteen guests were present.

The meeting was opened with prayer by Frankie Mathis, pastor of the Cornerstone Cowboy Church and the Pledge of Allegiance.

The January minutes were approved as written with a motion from Mr. Cordray and second from Mr. Arbuckle. All ayes.

General fund bills were approved with a motion from Mr. Cordray and second from Mr. Arbuckle. All ayes.


Utility fund bills were approved with a motion from Mr. Arbuckle and second from Mr. Morvan. All ayes.

A proposal from David Lawler Construction for \$31,800 and a quote from Delta Process Equipment for \$23,000, totaling \$54,800 to replace the Uncas Street lift station was approved with a motion from Mrs. Williams and second from Mr. Arbuckle. All ayes.

With a motion from Mrs. Williams and second from Mr. Arbuckle it was approved for Marsha O. Millican, CPA to perform the 2012 audit. All ayes.

Pastor of Cornerstone Cowboy Church, Frankie Mathis, along with several church members, addressed the council regarding the possibility of Cornerstone Cowboy Church taking over the management of the Logansport Municipal Rodeo Arena. The church has several events planned for this year including, but not limited to an LRCA Rodeo in August. There are some repairs needed at the arena that the church is willing to make. Two motions were made regarding the arena. With a motion from Mr. Cordray and second from Mr. Morvan it was approved to allow the Cornerstone Cowboy Church to manage the event scheduling of the Logansport Municipal Rodeo Arena for the year 2013. It was, also, approved with a motion from Mr. Cordray and second from Mr. Morvan to have the church keep a record of the money spent on rodeo repairs and offset against rodeo arena expenses paid by the Town to determine a fair compensation to the Town for the church's use of the arena. With no further action to be voted on, the meeting adjourned with a motion from Mr. Arbuckle and second from Mr. Cordray. All ayes.
