

TOWN OF LOGANSPORT
MINUTES
November 12, 2013

The regular meeting of the Logansport Town Council was held Tuesday, November 12, 2013, at 6:00 p.m. in the Council Chamber with Mayor Katherine Freeman presiding. Council members present: Norman Arbuckle, Judge Cordray, Martha Guillotte, Dale Morvan, and Edith Williams. Six guests were in attendance.

The meeting opened with the Lord's Prayer and the Pledge of Allegiance.

The October minutes were approved as written with a motion from Mrs. Williams and second from Mr. Arbuckle. All ayes.

General fund bills were approved with a motion from Mr. Cordray and second from Mr. Morvan. All ayes.

Utility fund bills were approved with a motion from Mr. Arbuckle and second from Mrs. Williams. All ayes.

With a motion from Mr. Arbuckle and second from Mrs. Williams, Ordinance #692—SWEPCO Franchise Agreement, was introduced with a public hearing set for Tuesday, December 10, 2013, at 6:00 p.m. All ayes.

With a motion from Mrs. Guillotte and second from Mr. Arbuckle, Ordinance #693—Video Franchise Fees, was introduced with a public hearing set for Tuesday, December 10, 2013, at 6:00 p.m. All ayes.

With a motion from Mr. Cordray and second from Mr. Arbuckle, a renewal of the employee group healthcare plan with Humana was approved. All ayes.

The 2014 proposed budget was presented and is available at Town Hall for public review. A public hearing will be held Tuesday, December 10, 2013 at 6:00 p.m. in the Council Chamber for comments or questions. Immediately following the public hearing, the 2014 budget will be approved with final revisions.

John Russell addressed the Council regarding the terrible condition of Highway 5 between Logansport and Keachi. He suggested letters of endorsement from both the Town and the Logansport Chamber of Commerce, to Senator Buffington and Representative Burford expressing these concerns seemed appropriate. With a motion from Mr. Morvan and second from Mr. Arbuckle it was unanimously approved to send letters to both Senator Sherri Smith Buffington and Representative Richard Burford expressing concerns over the terrible condition of Highway 5 between Logansport and Keachi.

Mrs. Guillotte reported the substation had written 24 citations the month of October and collected a total of \$3,244.50 in fines.

With no further business to discuss, the meeting adjourned with a motion from Mr. Cordray and second from Mr. Arbuckle.
