

TOWN OF LOGANSPORT
MINUTES
August 12, 2014

The regular meeting of the Logansport Town Council was held Tuesday, August 12, 2014, at 6:00 p.m. in the Council Chamber at Logansport Town Hall with Mayor Katherine Freeman presiding. Council members present: Norman Arbuckle, Judge Cordray, Martha Guillotte, Dale Morvan, and Edith Williams. Absent: None. Six guests were in attendance.

The meeting was opened with the Lord's Prayer and Pledge of Allegiance.

The Mayor presented a Certificate of Appreciation to the DeSoto Fire District #1 for the outstanding 4th of July Fireworks Show. Gayle Canton, wife of District #1 Fire Chief Jack Canton accepted the certificate on behalf of the Fire Department.

With a motion from Mr. Arbuckle and second from Mrs. Guillotte the July minutes were approved as written. All ayes.

Both general fund and utility fund bills were approved with a motion from Mr. Morvan and second from Mr. Arbuckle. All ayes.

The Mayor opened the floor for public comments. Debbie Amox inquired as to what could possibly be done to the vacant storefronts on Main Street to enhance the appearance of both the Downtown area as well as the vacant buildings. She suggested the Council adopt an ordinance requiring vacant buildings in the downtown area to have a "false front". Mrs. Amox also inquired as to what could be done to slow the traffic down in the downtown area, stating it was very dangerous, as well as, difficult to back out when parked in the downtown area.

The 2013 Audit Report performed by Marsha O. Millican, CPA was presented for review.

With a motion from Mrs. Williams and second from Mr. Arbuckle, it was approved to engage Marsha O. Millican, CPA to perform the Town's annual audit for years 2014, 2015, and 2016. All ayes.

Mrs. Guillotte presented the sheriff sub-station report, stating there were 113 total calls resulting in 33 citations and 8 arrests, for and a total of \$2435.50 collected in fines for the month of July.

With no further business to discuss, the meeting adjourned with a motion from Mrs. Guillotte and second from Mr. Arbuckle. All ayes.
