

TOWN OF LOGANSPORT  
MINUTES  
December 9, 2014

The regular meeting of the Logansport Town Council was held Tuesday, December 9, 2014, in the Council Chamber at Logansport Town Hall with Mayor Katherine Freeman presiding. Council members present: Norman Arbuckle, Judge Cordray, Martha Guillotte, Dale Morvan, and Edith Williams. Absent: None. Four guests were in attendance.

The meeting opened with prayer from Mayor Katherine Freeman and the Pledge of Allegiance.

With a motion from Mrs. Williams and second from Mr. Morvan a public hearing was opened to address any questions regarding the 2015 proposed budget. Jean Borders had questions regarding the Christmas Lighting Expense and also the amount of money budgeted for street repairs. No one else had any questions and the public hearing closed with a motion from Mr. Cordray and second from Mr. Arbuckle.

The November minutes were approved as written with a motion from Mrs. Williams and second from Mr. Arbuckle. All ayes.

Both the general fund and utility fund bills were approved with a motion from Mr. Arbuckle and second from Mrs. Williams. All ayes.

With a motion from Mr. Cordray and second from Mr. Arbuckle, the 2015 Budget was approved as presented. All ayes.

The 2014 budget amendments were approved as presented with a motion from Mrs. Williams and second from Mrs. Guillotte. All ayes.

John Russell addressed the council regarding the idea of exploring the possibility of building a floating dock on the riverfront somewhere around the RiverStage, similar to the one recently constructed by the DeSoto Police Jury at Garrett's Park. He stated that possibly monetary support from other entities could be obtained for the construction. Everyone agreed that a floating dock would be a great asset to Riverfront Park.

With a motion from Mr. Cordray and second from Mrs. Guillotte, Dale Morvan's resignation from the Town Council was accepted with regret effective 12/31/2014. All ayes.

With a motion from Mr. Cordray and second from Mr. Arbuckle, it was decided to appoint the next person with the highest votes during the last Town Council election, which would be June Hooper, to serve in Mr. Morvan's place until such time that an election could be called. All ayes.


