

TOWN OF LOGANSPOURT  
MINUTES  
November 11, 2014

The regular meeting of the Logansport Town Council was held Tuesday, November 11, 2014 in the Council Chamber at Logansport Town Hall with Mayor Katherine Freeman presiding. Council members present: Norman Arbuckle, Judge Cordray, Martha Guillotte, Dale Morvan, and Edith Williams. Absent: None. One guest was in attendance.

The meeting opened with the Lord's Prayer and the Pledge of Allegiance.

With a motion from Mr. Cordray and second from Mr. Morvan the October minutes were approved as written. All ayes.

The General fund and Utility fund bills were approved with a motion from Mr. Morvan and second from Mrs. Guillotte. All ayes.

There were no public comments and no old business to discuss.

Zach Bossier had inquired at Town Hall about placing a speed bump on 3<sup>rd</sup> Street near his place of business. However, the Council decided not to grant the request due to it being a street connecting East & West bound Main Street traffic once construction is completed.

A speed bump and "Children at Play" sign were requested on Willow Street. The Council okayed a "Children at Play" sign, but not a speed bump.


With a motion from Mr. Arbuckle and second from Mr. Morvan it was decided to take a property tax millage increase of 7.5 mills to a public vote and to begin procedures to have it placed on the spring ballot. All ayes.

The 2015 proposed budget was presented by the Clerk. With a motion from Mrs. Williams and second from Mr. Arbuckle, a public hearing was called for 12/9/14 for general comments on the 2015 budget proposal. All ayes. Following the public hearing the 2015 budget will be adopted at the regularly scheduled council meeting.

Mrs. Guillotte reported that \$3,179.50 was collected in fines for the month of October, but no police report was received from Deputy Carol Richardson as to the number of calls and citations in October.
