

MINUTES
TOWN OF LOGANSPOUR
July 14, 2015

The regular meeting of the Logansport Town Council was held Tuesday, July 14, 2015 at 6:00 p.m. in the Council Chamber of Logansport Town Hall with Mayor Katherine Freeman presiding. Council members present: Norman Arbuckle, Judge Cordray, Martha Guillotte, June Hooper, and Edith Williams. Absent: None. Two guests were in attendance.

Edith Williams opened the meeting with prayer and the Pledge of Allegiance.

With a motion from Mrs. Williams and second from Mr. Arbuckle the June minutes were approved as written. All ayes.

The monthly bills were approved with a motion from Mr. Cordray and second from Mr. Arbuckle. All ayes.

Mayor Freeman appointed Mr. Arbuckle, Mr. Cordray, and Mrs. Guillotte to serve on a committee to update our property codes. It was suggested that Dean Runnels be asked to attend one of the meetings to interpret the International Property Code and make suggestions as to what parts of it should be incorporated into the Town's code.

With a motion from Mr. Arbuckle and second from Mrs. Hooper, it was approved to explore the possibility of extending the Town's corporate limits North on Hwy 5 past the old LP property, East of Hwy 5 to include the Oden Subdivision, and East on Hwy 84 to Bethel Road/Hwy 191. All ayes. Mayor Freeman suggested asking Max Lecompe with the Coordinating and Development Corp to assist us.

The 2014 Audit Report performed by Marsha Millican, CPA was presented and accepted with a motion from Mr. Arbuckle and second from Mrs. Williams. All ayes.

The following resolutions to begin the LCDBG grant application were adopted:

1. Procurement Procedures Policy --presented by Mrs. Williams and second by Mrs. Guillotte. All ayes.
2. Administrative Consultant's Proposal for Services—presented by Mrs. Williams and second by Mr. Arbuckle. All ayes.
3. Engineer's Qualifications Statements—presented by Mr. Williams and second by Mr. Arbuckle. All ayes.

Mrs. Guillotte reported there were 172 calls that were responded to by the sub-station for the month of June and 22 citations written for a total of \$1,098.

With no further business to discuss, the meeting adjourned with a motion from Mrs. Williams and second from Mr. Arbuckle. All ayes.
