

MINUTES  
TOWN OF LOGANSPOUR  
March 10, 2015

The regular meeting of the Logansport Town Council was held Tuesday, March 10, 2015, in the Council Chamber of Logansport Town Hall with Mayor Katherine Freeman presiding. Council members present: Norman Arbuckle, Judge Cordray, Martha Guillotte, June Hooper and Edith Williams. Absent: None. Three guests were in attendance.

The meeting opened with the Lord's Prayer and the Pledge of Allegiance.

Mayor Freeman presented a plaque to Teresa Stephens, Mardi Gras Festival Chairman, in appreciation of her time and dedication in making all of the Mardi Gras festivities a huge success.

With a motion from Mr. Cordray and second from Mrs. Williams, the February minutes were approved as written. All ayes.

General fund and Utility fund bills were approved with a motion from Mr. Arbuckle and second from Mrs. Hooper. All ayes.

John Russell addressed the Council regarding the floating dock that is going to be constructed along the banks of Riverfront Park. He stated the final cost will be \$35,000 and that construction can begin as soon as \$17,500 is paid to the contractor. The Logansport Chamber of Commerce is committing \$10,000 to the project and plans are to approach the DeSoto Police Jury, Tourist Bureau and the SRA for funds.

With a motion from Mr. Arbuckle and second from Mrs. Guillotte a tree planting project on the riverfront sponsored by teacher, Alan Bagley's Logansport High School Ag Class was approved. All ayes.

Town Hall office hours will change to 8:00-4:00 Monday, Tuesday, Thursday, and Friday and 8:00-12:00 noon on Wednesday, effective 3/16/15 with a motion from Mrs. Williams and second from Mr. Arbuckle. All ayes.

Mrs. Guillotte reported \$3,116 in fines, but had no figures from the sub-station for number of calls, citations, and arrests.

With no further business to discuss the meeting adjourned with a motion from Mr. Cordray and second from Mr. Arbuckle. All ayes.
