

MINUTES
TOWN OF LOGANSPOUR
May 12, 2015

The regular meeting of the Logansport Town Council was held Tuesday, May 12, 2015, at 6:00 p.m. in The Council Chamber of Logansport Town Hall with Mayor Katherine Freeman presiding. Council members present: Norman Arbuckle, Judge Cordray, Martha Guillotte, June Hooper and Edith Williams. Absent: None. Thirty two guests were in attendance.

Mayor Freeman opened the meeting with prayer and the Pledge of Allegiance.

Mayor Katherine Freeman presented Certificates of Achievement to students who participated in "Discovering & Preserving the History of Our Town" by researching and presenting projects representing different places, people, events, etc. pertaining to Logansport. This event was sponsored by the Logansport Historical Committee with Logansport teacher Wendy Shinault overseeing the projects.

With a motion from Mr. Arbuckle and second from Mrs. Williams the April minutes were approved as written. All ayes.

General fund and Utility fund bills were approved as presented with a motion from Mr. Cordray and second from Mrs. Guillotte. All ayes.

With a motion from Mr. Arbuckle and second from Mrs. Williams a resolution setting the property tax millage for 2015 at 7.49 mills was adopted. All ayes.

A resolution adopting a citizen participation plan for the LCDBG program was passed with a motion from Mr. Arbuckle and second from Mrs. Guillotte. All ayes.

Mayor Freeman presented the International Property Maintenance Code and asked council members to study the code and consider adopting it as a town ordinance, possibly introducing it at next month's council meeting.

Mr. Cordray reported that the everything is on "hold" with the floating dock until the "okay" is received from the army corp. of engineers, which hopefully will be any day.

Mrs. Guillotte reported that the sub-station responded to 172 calls and issued 20 citations for the month of April with \$2,587.50 collected in fines.

With no further business to discuss, the meeting adjourned with a motion from Mr. Arbuckle and second from Mrs. Hooper. All ayes.
