

MINUTES
TOWN OF LOGANSPOURT
January 12, 2016

The regular meeting of the Logansport Town Council was held Tuesday, January 12, 2016 at 5:00 p.m. in the Council Chamber of Logansport Town Hall with Mayor Katherine Freeman presiding. Council members present: Norman Arbuckle, Judge Cordray, Martha Guillotte, June Hooper, and Edith Williams. Absent: None. Seventeen guests were in attendance.

The meeting was opened with prayer by Edith Williams and the Pledge of Allegiance.

With a motion from Mr. Cordray and second from Mr. Arbuckle the December minutes were approved as written. All ayes.

The monthly bills were approved with a motion from Mrs. Williams and second from Mrs. Hooper. All ayes.

There were no public comments or old business to discuss.

John Paul Moore addressed the council regarding the new code enforcements and stated that he, as well as many others, was not familiar with all the ordinances, especially those pertaining to the residential areas in town. Mr. Bryant, the Code Enforcement Officer, explained he was working on a "mail out" to be sent to all of the Town's residents explaining issues that were going to be addressed regarding clean-up and beautification of our Town. He also plans to publicize in the local paper.

The Council was asked to consider proposing an ordinance banning aerial fireworks in the residential areas of Town and banning aerial fireworks in all other areas unless properly bonded.

Mrs. Guillotte reported that the Sub-station had responded to 188 calls in December and issued 14 citation. A total of only \$649.00 was collected in fines for the month of December.

Deputy Carol Richardson explained the process for collecting delinquent fines.

With n further business to discuss, the meeting adjourned with a motion from Mrs. Hooper and second from Mrs. Guillotte. All ayes.
