

MINUTES
TOWN OF LOGANSPOUR
January 9, 2017

The regular monthly meeting of the Logansport Town Council was held Tuesday, January 9, 2017 at 6:00 p.m. in the Council Chamber of Logansport Town Hall with Mayor Judge Cordray presiding. Council members present: Norman Arbuckle, Katherine Freeman, Dwight Gatlin, Martha Guillotte and Pam Thomas. Absent: None. Six guests were in attendance.

The meeting was opened with the Lord's Prayer and the Pledge of Allegiance.

The December 2016 minutes were approved as written with a motion from Ms. Freeman and second from Mrs. Guillotte. All ayes.

Monthly bills were approved with a motion from Mr. Arbuckle and second from Ms. Thomas. All ayes.

Mark Armstrong addressed the Council during the Public Comments segment of the meeting requesting authorization to place an "iTour USA" sign by the Louisiana monument in Riverfront Park. "iTour USA is a personal tour guide to *Discover ALL of America*. It is an on-location, internet-based, personal tour that may include multimedia presentations, such as interactive maps, streaming video, photographs, audio podcasts, and other media specific to that particular iTour USA site. Local businesses and organizations are also able to participate by joining the iTour Usa directory associated with the site marker sign.

Mr. Armstrong also inquired about maintaining the Town's website and Facebook page.


With a motion from Mr. Arbuckle and second from Ms. Thomas it was approved for the Mayor to sign a Cooperative Endeavor with the Sabine River Authority in the amount of \$30,000 for the construction of a splash pad on the Riverfront. All ayes.



Mr. Arbuckle reported that for the month of December 17 citations were issued, with 7 arrests. There were 137 calls for service. A total of \$2,538.50 was collected in fines.
